LOC Offices - Secretariat

The 2010 Golden Age Gym Festival secretariat will be located at the Tennis Center. This area will be open only to UEG Representatives/Staff, Federation Officials, Head of Delegations/group leaders and authorized LOC members. Throughout the venues our team will be in conditions to provide full assistance/help to all delegation members that do required it.

The working schedule from October 1st to October 8th is 8h15 to 18h00. On October 9th you will be able to reach secretariat staff via phone. Secretariat Phone Number: +351961511999.

At these facilities the LOC secures the following services:

- Accreditation;
- Payments and/or refunds;
- Updated event Information;
- Transportation Schedules (plus updates – when available);
- Information on Medical Assistance;
- Excursions desk (for Program information and make last minute reservations);
- Management of hotel requests;
- Lost and found

At this occasion we would like to remind all the registered delegations/groups of the following:

- a) The LOC must get written information October 3rd of the responsible person for the “picking-up” the accreditations. At this time we need to be informed of the estimated arrival date and time. Furthermore all the National Federations must confirm which delegation members are allowed to pick up the accreditations (specially when the team/group arrives before the Head of Delegation/Federation responsible);
- b) During the accreditation the Head of Delegation/Group Leader (HoD/GL) must present the proof of the groups personal insurance (accidents and illness) plus reconfirm all the registered participants (numbers and reservations);
- c) Should the HoD/GL fail to proof this insurance or doesn't have a valid insurance, the LOC will offer an insurance by the value of 50 EURO per week per person.

Do take into attention that only the registered delegations/groups that have booked accommodation through our LOC and provide in time their arrival/departure plans will benefit of the “LOC Faro Airport” transfer service.

In the same way only Delegation Members holding Participant Cards will have access to all event benefits (free official hotel-venue-official hotel transfers and to the negotiated discounts).



Group Agenda

Every group leader will, at the arrival, receive a group agenda including information, regarding: workshop placement, transportation, information regarding performances, etc. The group agenda is individual for each group and will give the group leader an overview of the week program for the specific group. This information will be provided at least one week before the event.

Apart from this dossier we call the participants attention that in the official hotels will be displayed updates in transportation schedule and other useful information.

Parade - Sunday

The order of delegations behind the band will be in French alphabetical order by country names and will be in rows of 4 people. The delegation of Portugal will come at the end of the line. The Head of Delegation must together with the group leaders arrange these rows.

Each National Federation should appoint one flag bearer.

To see the Opening Ceremony the LOC will provide seated places to all delegations.

The Opening Ceremony will begin when the last group is installed.

Performances - Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday 18h00 *

The time for each performance is allocated accordingly the information provided in the registration form, including setting up and packing up of apparatus. The group is responsible to set up and storage the gymnastics equipment they will use. Groups must arrive 30 minutes before their performance time. They must give their music, CD (only .wav files) to the person in charge at the venue. The name of the group and its code (in English) must be marked on both the CD and its outer cover. It is advised to bring an extra CD in case of lost.

At each venue, or nearby you will find a dressing room, a first aid post and toilets.

The organizing committee accepts no responsibility in case of lost or stolen valuables.

At the workshop venues there will be guides and signs telling you where to go and where to find your workshop. Between the first and second workshop (each day), you have to find the guides again, so they can guide you to the next workshop.

The rehearsal schedule will be sent directly to the teams.






